

Getting to The Edge

The Edge, 34 Endcliffe Crescent, SHEFFIELD S10 3ED

By car

Parking on the Endcliffe Village site is very restricted; there is some on-site parking which may be used if you pre-arrange a permit. There is on-road parking in the surrounding streets.

From the north, south and east (M1, M18)

Approach Sheffield on the M1 and leave the motorway at Junction 33, following the City Centre signs along the dual carriageway A630/A57/A61 Parkway, which ends in a large roundabout – Park Square. From here, take the third exit, the A61(S), along Sheaf Street, following the Ring Road and University signs, and passing the railway station on the left. At Granville Square turn right onto the Ring Road and continue straight on as far as the third roundabout, the Brook Hill roundabout. Take the first exit (Brook Hill), and continue for about one mile/ 1500 metres, past the University and Children's Hospital. Go straight on at all the traffic lights, and continue ahead into Fulwood Road. Turn second left into Endcliffe Crescent.

From the west (A57 Snake Pass)

Follow the 'City Centre' signs. About 300 metres after the BP filling station, turn right into Shore Lane. At the bottom turn left and then right into Endcliffe Crescent.

By Train

Sheffield is at the heart of the railway network. Regular services operate between Sheffield and London St Pancras (2½ hours), Birmingham (1¼ hours), Leeds (1 hour), Manchester (1 hour) and Nottingham (1 hour). The 40 bus stop is a short walk away – stand D6 at the transport interchange.

Local Transport

By taxi

There are taxi ranks at the Railway Station and the City Hall. The journey to The Edge can take 20 minutes; you should expect to pay about £8.

By bus

The 40 bus service departs from the transport interchange (stand D6); it runs every 10 minutes during daytime weekdays and Saturdays, and every 20 minutes until midnight in the evening and Sundays. Ask for the Endcliffe Crescent stop.
The 80 bus also runs close to The Edge.
