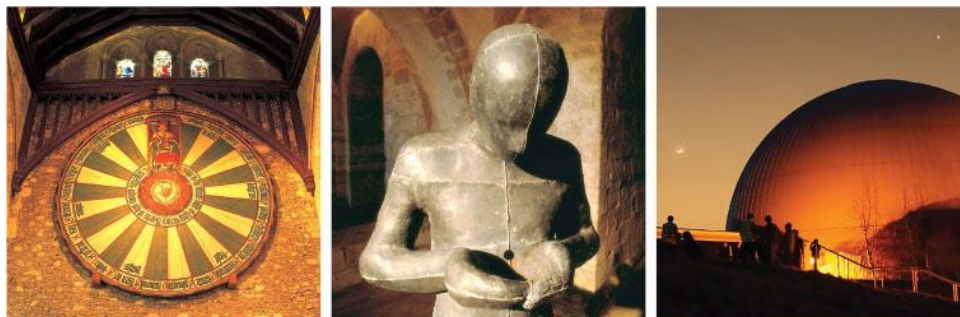

Car parking: Car parking on campus is limited, can be exceptionally busy over the summer and is available on a first come basis. Please use public transport, park and ride or car share wherever possible. Please be aware that all parking at the University requires a valid parking permit; please display this permit at all times to prevent ticketing. Parking permits can be collected from the bedroom check in-desk at St Swithuns' Lodge or the Stripe Conference registration desk on arrival.

For more details about park and ride, click on the link [here](#). The nearest bus stop to the University is outside the Royal Hampshire County hospital on Romsey Road, a short (3 minute) walk from the campus. All buses on the service stop here.

Accommodation: For delegates staying on campus:

Tuesday/Wednesday: Keys can be picked up from Reception at St Swithuns Lodge from 14:00. Reception is open until 19:00. If you arrive after this time you can phone security on 07962 872666 to arrange to pick up your room key.

Thursday/Friday: You can pick up your room key from the meeting registration desk in the Stripe Building foyer.

Luggage storage will be available on the ground floor of the Stripe Building.

Bedrooms include towel, bed linen and toiletry pack.

A minimum amount of coat hangers are included.

An iron and ironing board will be available in the hallway cupboard within each flat.

Tea/coffee making facilities are available in nearby shared kitchens.

Hairdryers are **not** included.
