How to access Cardiff University Guest Wi-Fi whilst attending your conference:

To connect your mobile device, simply:

- Click on 'CU-Visitor' from the list of wireless networks available.
- Click 'I am here for a 'Conference/School open day'.
- Select 'I don't have a username and would like to register'.
- You'll be asked to register your name, email address, mobile phone number and conference ID.
(The Conference ID is: BRS2019)
- Click 'Register'. You'll then receive a text message with a username and password to log in to the wireless network.

If you don't receive a text within a few minutes, try switching your phone off and on again.
